The Coalition for the Upper South Platte is pleased to announce a unique opportunity for fire mitigation work in cooperation with Teller County. This is available to neighborhoods outside of City Limits in Teller County only.

Teller County will provide partial matching funds to assist mitigating possible hazard trees on road rights-of-way adjacent to private property. As you may know, the right-of-way is generally about 60' wide as platted, but rarely is constructed that wide. Trees in this area between a property line and the physical road have the potential fall and to block travel for residents and emergency responders in the event of a wildfire, or other emergency.

This is a voluntary program for property owners to jump start important fire risk reduction work in your subdivision. CUSP will work closely with owners to identify the right-of-way where property corners aren't marked. A professional contractor will cut the trees and chip the slash under the direction of CUSP. The owners may keep the wood, or it can be donated to area charity.

This is a cost share program and property owners and/or homeowner associations will need to share the cost of the work.

Please let us know if your area would be interested in this project, and enough property owners would participate to create meaningful work.
